

**SPECIAL COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS**

The special meeting of the Flat Rock City Council convened at the Municipal Building in Council Chambers on the above date at 7:30 p.m.

**1. PRESENT ON ROLL CALL:** Mayor Dropiewski, Council Members Martin, Gagne, Painter, Wrobel and Moore.

**THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS TO SET THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE 2010-2011 BUDGET.**

06-28-02 Motion by Martin supported by Gagne to set the millage rate at 17.25 which is 16.00 mills for General Operations, .25 mills for Historical and 1.00 mill for the Library.

Mayor Dropiewski said 17.25 mills with up to 1.00 for the Library and .25 for the Historical.

Martin said you can't adopt an "up to" millage.

Mayor discussed the AAI refund and why he is budgeting for it.

Wrobel said let the people vote on whether they want a millage increase or not.

Moore questioned if the .25 mill would be allocated for furlough days or laid off employees and the Mayor said he didn't know.

Sue Daddario spoke on behalf of the Library Board against reducing the millage for the Library.

Joanne Beard clarified the contributions to the Library.

Residents Arlen Fadely, Joseph Marron, Bill Rice, Frank Hamet, Roger Skibski and Glen Owens shared their views against a millage increase.

Martin said his original motion still stands. Vote on the motion was 4-2 with Dropiewski and Painter voting no.

06-28-03 Motion by Martin supported by Painter to adjourn the special meeting at 8:03 pm.

All present voting yes. Motion carried unanimously.
