The special meeting of the Flat Rock City Council convened at the Municipal Building in Council Chambers on the above date at 7:30 p.m.

1. PRESENT ON ROLL CALL: Mayor Dropiewski, Council Members Martin, Gagne, Painter, Wrobel and Moore.

ABSENT: Council Member Tefend.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS A SOUTH HURON VALLEY WORK SESSION RE: RESOLUTION OF OUTSTANDING ISSUES.

Richard Hinshon, P.E. of Hinshon Environmental Consulting, did a power point presentation of the history and development of the South Huron Valley Authority and the unresolved issues.

Under History and Development of the system, Mr. Hinshon covered (1) the early years under Wayne County from 1983 – 1991 (2) system growth and expansion from 1992 – 1998 (3) Utility Authority takeover period from 1999 – 2003 and (4) the modern era from 2004 – 2010.

Under Unresolved Issues of the system, Mr. Hinshon covered (1) establish cost allocation for future capital improvements (2) install liner in deteriorating Trenton Arm interceptor and (3) clean, inspect and rehabilitate the “orphan pipes”.

Extensive discussion continued with Mr. Hinshon, Mayor and Council Members and former Mayor, Richard Jones.
